Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of resolutions of the Board of Education of the Struthers City School District, County of Mahoning, Ohio, adopted on December 15, 2020 and January 12, 2021, there will be submitted to the electors of the Struthers City School District at an election to be held in that School District at the regular places of voting therein, on Tuesday, May 4, 2021, the question of levying a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the School District for the purpose of current expenses, at a rate not exceeding 6.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 69 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years. Said tax constitutes the renewal of all of an existing 6.9 mill levy. If a majority of the voters voting thereon vote in favor thereof, that levy will be first placed on the tax list and duplicate in December 2021 for first collection in calendar year 2022.
